

Works by Susan Botti, including a world premiere of Mangetsu

The UMBC Music Department presents Moon and Myth, a concert of contemporary vocal chamber music by composer/soprano, Susan Botti. Renowned musicians Airi Yoshioka (violin), James Wilson (cello), and Carsten Schmidt (piano) join Botti in her work *Dido Refuses to Speak*, featuring the poetry of Linda Gregerson (special UMBC Writer-in-Residence). A world premiere of a new work for voice and violin commissioned by Yoshioka/UMBC will also be on the program. Among Botti's accomplishments are commissions for the New York Philharmonic, the Orpheus Chamber Orchestra, and the Cleveland Orchestra; awards include a Guggenheim Fellowship and The Rome Prize.
